Our longest running programs, summer camps and fall retreats, continue to be beacons of light as they unashamedly proclaim the Gospel of Christ and introduce thousands of students from all over the country to Jesus each year.

In Haiti, we have seen lives and communities change through the work of our children's homes, schools, and hospital. These projects continue to make significant impacts in the Cap Haitian community.

# PITTSBURGH

Surf City and Laurelville Mud Weekends are the two camps that we run each year for middle school and high school students. These camps introduce students to Jesus and inspire them to live life with Him.

The Pittsburgh Kids Network is a community of local youth leaders dedicated to student ministry. We encourage and equip these front-line ministry workers through our monthly meetings which provide space for corporate worship, teaching, small group discussion, and a meal.

The Pittsburgh Youth Workers Conference is an annual event that brings high level, practical youth ministry teaching to Pittsburgh. Youth leaders from all over the region come to worship, learn, and grow together.

The Women in Youth Ministry program is a community of women who are working in youth ministry or are married to youth pastors. Women gather monthly to share the highlights and the challenges of youth ministry and support each other.

# HAITI

We're passionate about seeing students succeed and developing the next generation of spiritual leaders. In Pittsburgh, local churches, youth groups, and students' families are close partners. Haiti lacks much of the support system we see in Pittsburgh, and families often struggle to provide. Because of this, we partner with children's homes and churches in the Cap Haitien area to provide base needs such as housing, medical care, food, safe water, and a Christian education. Currently, there are 171 kids in the three PKF-sponsored children's homes.

In 2018 the IDADEE Children's Home rescued nine additional children.

There are 225 students from the IDADEE Children's Home and the surrounding community enrolled in the IDADEE schools.

Each year we take a team and supplies to Haiti and work with student leaders to host Surf City Haiti, a week-long summer camp full of fun, games, and the Gospel message.

In its first year, the CHIDA Hospital served 9,614 patients. The hospital continues to grow in both scope of care and volume of patients. Currently, the emergency room treats an average of 74 patients per day, while the community health program serves 200 people in the surrounding community.

We partnered with Water Mission, to install nine safe water solutions in the IDADEE community. These solutions serve up to 30,000 people daily, as well as the entire IDADEE and CHIDA campuses.

*We invested **\$2.3 Million** in our work. **93.3%** of our total budget went directly to projects and programs that reach kids in Pittsburgh and Haiti.*
